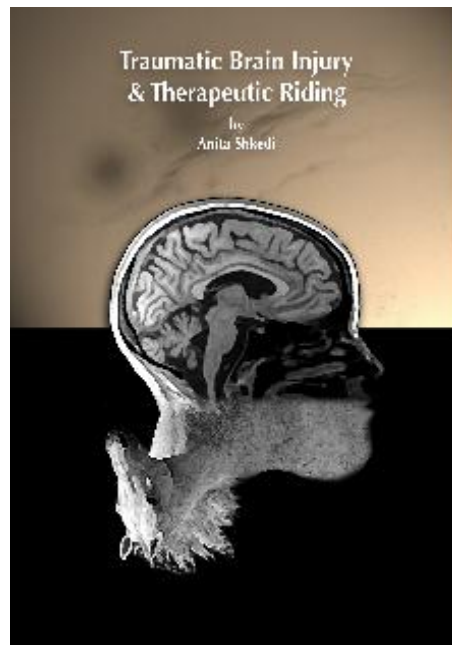


TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY & THERAPEUTIC RIDING
